

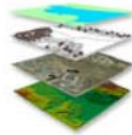

Data Inventory

An inventory of spatial (GIS) and tabular datasets used and created by various departments in the agency.



Data Request and Update Tracking

Tracks data that RIS requests and collects from cities, counties, and appraisal districts around the region.



GIS and Data User Guidance

Provides information about how we use GIS and data as an agency and covers available applications, where to find data, mapping standards, and best practices for effective data and knowledge management.



Demographic Handbook

Describes the locations of demographic datasets, documents, and other files maintained by RIS and created for NCTCOG use, and how to connect to them. **Note: We are working to integrate the Demographic Handbook and Data Inventory, but until then many of the datasets that you will find in the Demographic Handbook are not listed in the Data Inventory.**

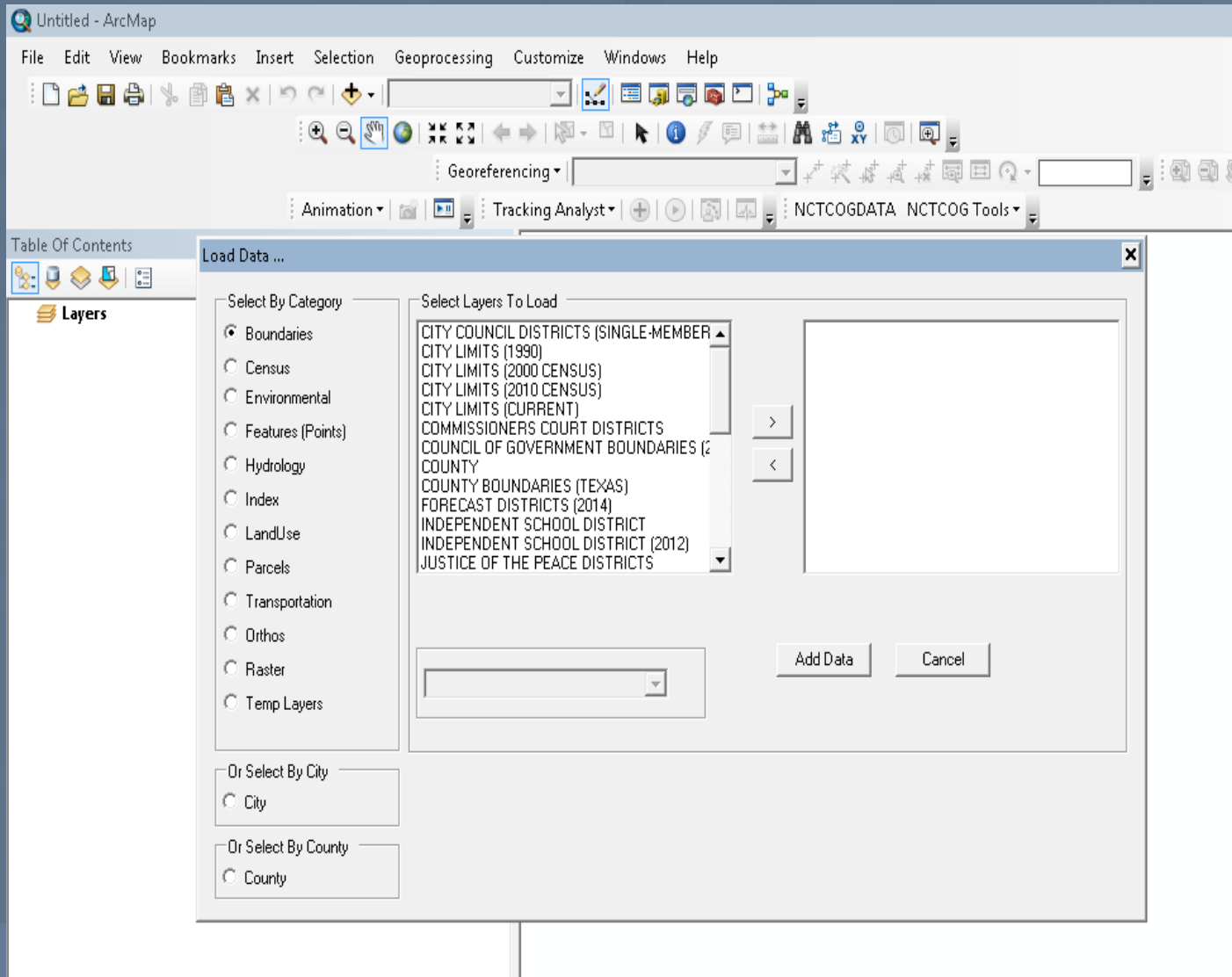
