1. **Welcome and introductions.**

The meeting began at 9:30 a.m. with introductions of all present.

3. **FY 2018 Work Program.** NCTCOG staff will give updates or solicit input for FY 2018 work program items. (Mia Brown)

- a. **Basic Dry Weather Field Screening Training.** NCTCOG staff will update the Task Force on plans for the June 27th Basic DWFS Training.

Mia Brown informed the Task Force that the Basic DWFS training would take place on June 27th, 2018, at the Carrollton Public Library – Josey Ranch Lake, and that staff from the City of Arlington would lead the training. Registration will open in May.

- b. **Industrial Inspectors Workshop.** NCTCOG staff will update the Task Force on details for the April 6th Municipal Industrial Inspectors Workshop.

Mia Brown gave the Task Force the details for the April 6th, 2018, Industrial Inspectors Workshop, including the final agenda, and that two spots remained for the training. Details for registered attendees would be sent via email at the end of the week.

- c. **IDDE Field Investigation Guide.** NCTCOG staff will review the IDDE Field Investigation Guide with the Task Force with its first round of comments incorporated and take any final comments.

The Task Force made a second quick review of the document, requesting some minor content additions. Mia said she would send it via email once complete.

4. **FY 2019 Work Program.** NCTCOG staff and IDDE Task Force members will discuss potential FY 2019 projects. (Mia Brown)

Mia Brown presented a draft list of potential FY 2019 work program items for consideration. The Task Force indicated that they would like to pursue two items: Basic/Advanced Dry Weather Field Screening training and literature on hot spots/priority areas.

5. **Roundtable Topics/Other Business.** The IDDE Task Force members and NCTCOG staff may share additional items as time allows.

Dallas Area Rapid Transit suggested that cities on rail lines partner with the respective rail entity to have safety inspectors report anything they see.

The City of Dallas mentioned that their stormwater program has been busy during the Atmos Energy gas pipeline replacement project.

The City of Hurst responded to a discharge of 32 industrial totes at a paint facility.

The City of Lewisville is investigating an illicit discharge from an outfall near a middle school that occurs intermittently.

The City of Fort Worth received their permit filing and will also be starting their dry weather field screening program soon.


