2.1 Local Supplemental Environmental Projects	Low	NCTCOG has provided information regarding the state level supplemental environmental projects (SEPs) procedures to become a Third-Party Administrator.
2.2 Land Use, Business, and Regulatory Review	Medium	TCEQ has made updates to the Multi-Sector General Permit that state receiving waters must be indicated as both category 4 and category 5 impaired waters.
