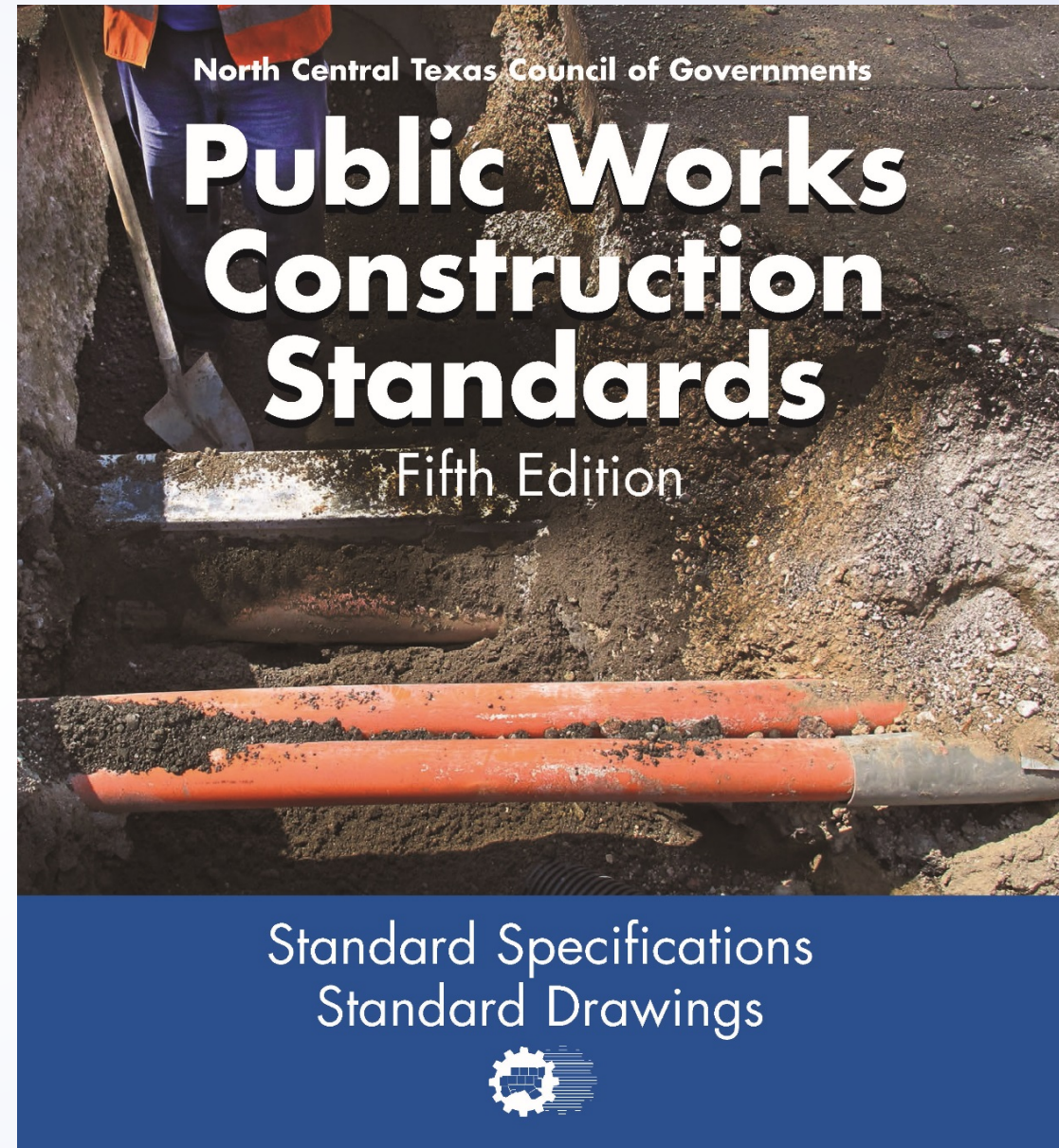
Sustainable Public Rights of Way (SPROW)

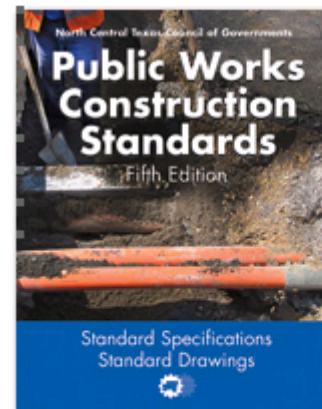

As part of the continued effort between NCTCOG and the public works industry in North Central Texas, Public Works Construction Standards – North Central Texas, 2004 Version is in the process of being updated for a fall 2017 release date.
