From farm to fork, we are losing 40% of our food supply. What does this mean to our local economy, our environment, and our social systems, and what can we do about it?

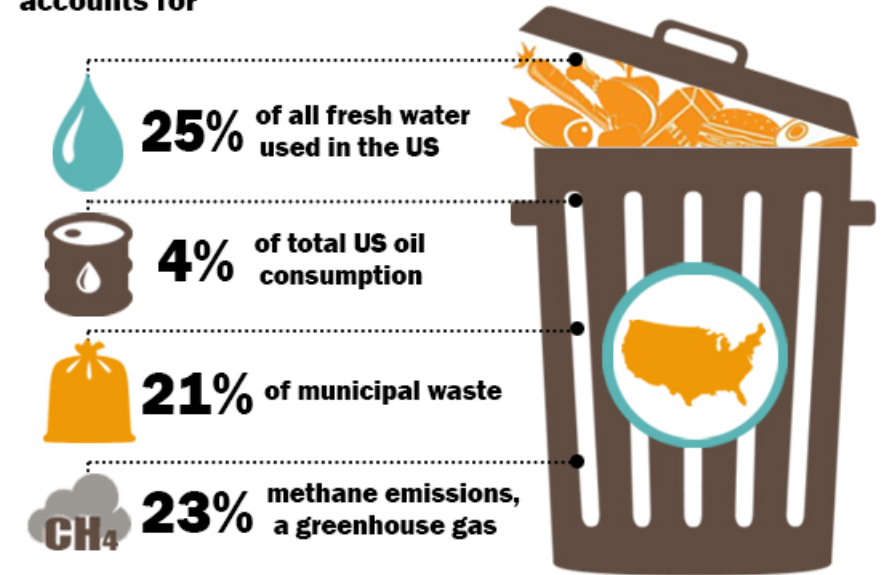
