

AIRCHECKTEXAS DRIVE A CLEAN MACHINE PROGRAM REPLACEMENT VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

Replacement vehicle requirements change on September 1, 2011. This will affect the model year, vehicle type, sales price and mileage of the replacement vehicle being purchased using the voucher. All replacement vehicles must meet the following requirements.
