**Comments/Goals**

- When communicating, committee agreed to use NCTCOG Fleet Committee so we know it is not spam or junk mail
- Identify non-financial benefits – emissions and energy consumption that when combined with the financial data provides a package to convince government officials PEVs are a good option
- Identify the fleets and the contact person. The fleet managers should be invited to get involved and volunteer time is needed to personally invite them
- Need to have life cycle information about the Electric Vehicle
- Need information on safety when an electric vehicle is in an accident, to allow for training of first responders to accident scenes
- Group agreed to develop list of what technology will be available in 2010 and 2011, and perhaps beyond
- Committee agreed on the need to encourage OEMS to put the electric vehicle on “STATE BUY BOARD / HGAC BUY”
- Must create financial and monetary plan – lifecycle cost analysis
- Find some idea that might bring about behavioral change and attitudes toward PEVs
- List incentives and rebates related to PEVs
- Determine government locations of recharging infrastructure
