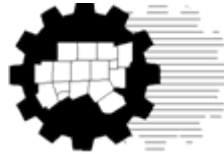

# **Joint Land Use Study**

## **Public Involvement Principles**

**Provide an open exchange of information and ideas between the public and participants in the Joint Land Use Study.**

**Be proactive in providing complete information, timely public notice, full public access to decision making, and opportunities for early and continuing involvement.**

**Involve all landowners who are potentially affected by the Joint Land Use Study and subsequent land development recommendations and decisions by providing an open forum where affected parties feel welcome and encouraged to participate in the study process.**

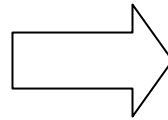
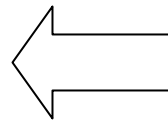
