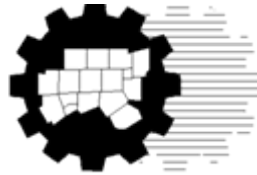

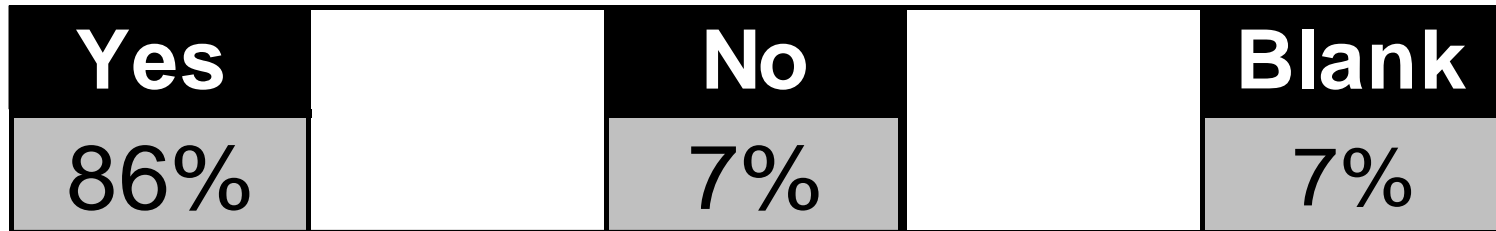

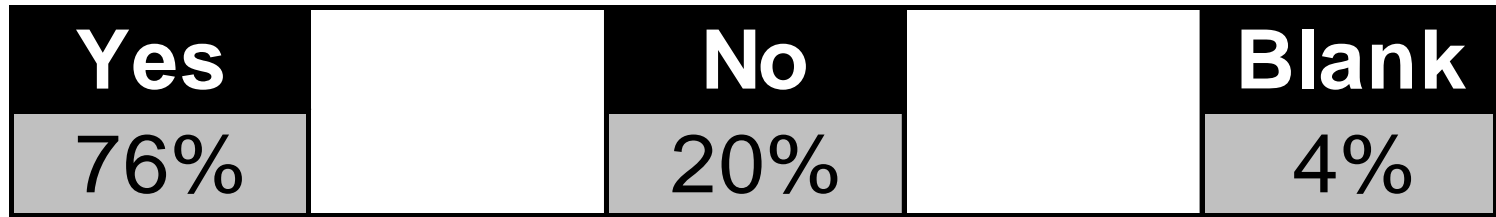
5. Do you support the voluntary purchase of easements on properties surrounding NAS JRB which would allow military flights?
