This letter is to confirm that we received the North Central Texas Council of Government's (NCTCOG) Title VI program on May 30, 2013, addressing the items listed in the Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) In Review letter issued dated February 4, 2014, to replace the Title VI program that expired on July 31, 2013. This submission is for the triennial cycle of August 1, 2013 to July 31, 2016, and replaces the program that expired on July 31, 2013. A Title VI Program submission is required pursuant to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; Title 49, Chapter 53, Section 5332 of the United States Code; and the Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) Circular 4702.1B, "Title VI Program Guidelines for Federal Transit Administration Recipients," effective October 1, 2012.

If we have not received all required information by the time your Title VI program expires, the NCTCOG may experience delays in processing grants or draw-down restrictions.
