About the Hunt County Transportation Committee:

The Hunt County Transportation Committee, comprised of elected and appointed city and county officials, business leaders and community leaders, led development of the Hunt County Transportation Plan. The committee sought significant input from across the county to ensure the final plan includes safe, efficient and affordable transportation options that support economic development and improve quality of life for residents today and in the future.

About the Metropolitan Planning Organization:

The NCTCOG Transportation Department and Regional Transportation Council (RTC) form the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for regional transportation planning in the Dallas-Fort Worth area. Federally designated as the MPO for the Dallas-Fort Worth area in 1974, the MPO works in cooperation with the region's transportation providers to address the complex transportation needs of the rapidly growing region. The 12-county Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolitan Planning Area includes Collin, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Hood, Hunt, Johnson, Kaufman, Parker, Rockwall, Tarrant and Wise counties.

Interconnected with nearly every aspect of our daily lives, transportation is an important topic of discussion today and into the future.

In coordination with the Hunt County Transportation Committee, local governments and the community, NCTCOG developed a draft multimodal transportation plan for Hunt County. The comprehensive county plan addresses challenges and opportunities, implementation guidance and incorporates studies and planning projects:

- Hunt County master thoroughfare plan
- Rail transportation and public transit feasibility study
- Hunt County bicycle and pedestrian plan
- Greenville land use analysis
- SH 34 corridor study
- Logistics hub feasibility study

The plan provides specific and strategic direction for meeting transportation needs during the next two decades in a county with a growing and diverse population. By integrating the development of Hunt County's transportation infrastructure with regional plans, economic development potential and quality of life improve for the county and North Texas. The public is invited to learn about and comment on the transportation plan.
