

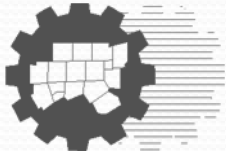

# 2011 TIGER Discretionary Grant Program

## Overview

- \$527 million multimodal, merit-based discretionary grant program
- \$140 million for rural areas  
(\$1 million minimum with no match requirement)
- Up to \$150 million for TIFIA\* payments
- Geographic diversity requirement
- Only three (3) applications per sponsor
- Surface transportation capital projects only (no planning funds)
- 20% match requirement (\$10 million minimum request)

\*Transportation Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act

- Economic Competitiveness
- Livability
- Environmental Sustainability
- Safety
- Job Creation/Near-Term Economic Activity
- Innovation
- Partnership

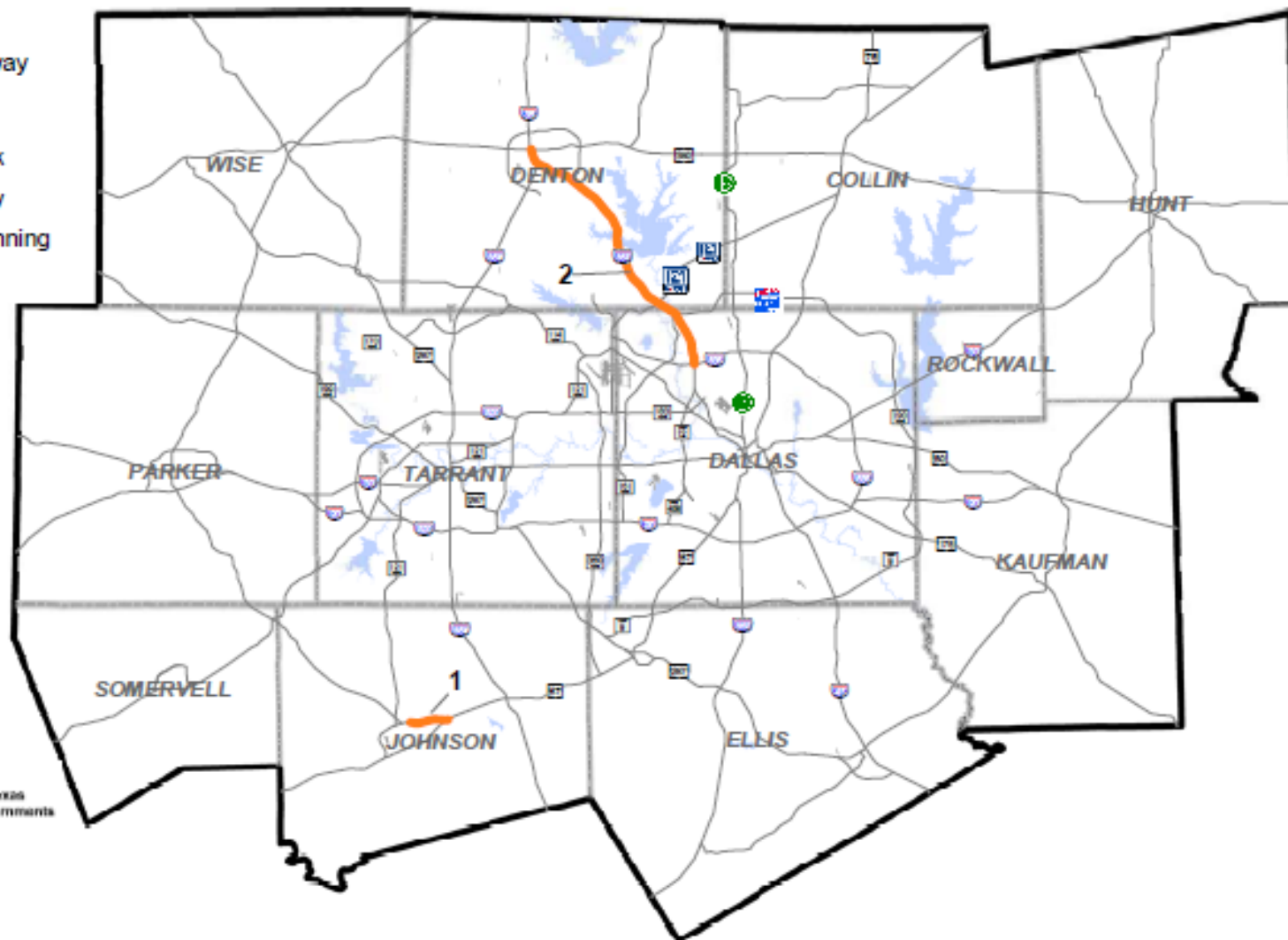
## Projects To Be Submitted by the Regional Transportation Council
