## Transportation Enhancement (TE)<sup>2</sup> 2012 Program Details

- Program Call Opened on Friday, September 14, 2012 and Closed November 16, 2012
- \$70 Million Available Statewide
  - \$35M Divided Between Large Metro Areas
    - > \$13,044,101 for NCTCOG
      - > \$9,000,430 Dallas/Paris Districts
      - > \$4,043,671 Fort Worth District
  - \$35M Selected by the Texas Transportation Commission (TTC)



## 2012 MPO Eligibility List Approved by RTC

- 1. Bicycle and pedestrian projects, including landscaping and education (land acquisition not listed as eligible).
- Restoration/operation of historic trolley or interurban rail lines and related structures, including landscaping (land acquisition not listed as eligible).
- 3. Restoration and operation of historic transit stations as new transit stations, including landscaping (land acquisition not listed as eligible).
- Acquisition of historic railroad rights of way for future rail and/or bicycle trails.
- 5. Landscaping transportation facilities.


- Regional Veloweb Impact (25%)
