NCTCOG Funding Available to Upgrade your Heavy-Duty Fleet!

The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) is offering approximately \$55 million to help North Texas operators modernize their fleets. Rebates are available now!

- **Total Funding Available:** Up to \$55.4M
- **Funding Type:** Rebate (no 2 CFR 200 requirements)
- **Eligible Applicants:** Public and private organizations
- **Eligible Projects:** Replacement of heavy-duty vehicles with zero-emission versions and installation of supporting infrastructure.
- **Eligible Vehicle Types:** This program is for "vocational vehicles" such as box trucks, step vans, refuse haulers, street sweepers, utility trucks, transit buses, flatbed trucks, stake trucks, fire trucks, coach buses, bucket trucks, dump trucks, etc.
- **Eligible Fuel Types:** Existing vehicles can be any internal combustion engine fuel. New vehicles must be battery-electric or hydrogen fuel cell electric.

NCTCOG has several resources to help applicants, including:

- Weekly virtual office hours with NCTCOG staff on Mondays at 10 AM CT
- **FREE** project development assistance from the National Lab of the Rockies
- **FREE** NCTCOG staff application assistance
- A zero-emission vehicle manufacturers and vendors inventory

Applications received on a modified first-come, first-served basis will be evaluated competitively. The deadline to apply is every 3rd Friday of the month at 5 PM CT, until all funds are exhausted. **Apply now and check our resources at www.nctcog.org/NTxZEV.**
