Welcome and Introductions. The Public Works Council (PWC) Chair will welcome everyone to the meeting.

Madisson Dunn (NCTCOG) welcomed attendees and reviewed housekeeping items.

ACTION ITEMS

1. **Meeting Summary Approval.** The [May 21, 2026, meeting summary](#) is available for review. Approval will be sought at the meeting.

Glenn Barker (Corinth) asked for a motion to approve the May 21, 2026, meeting summary. James Gaertner (Waxahachie) made a motion to approve the meeting summary. Glenn seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

2. **Public Works Council Nominations.** The PWC will vote to approve the nominees for FY2027-2028, including Chair and Vice Chair. Upon approval, appointments will go to the NCTCOG Executive Board for approval in September. NCTCOG will also recognize representatives who are retiring from the PWC. (Crysta Guzman)

Crysta Guzman (NCTCOG) shared the Council nominations and informed members that the nominations would be passed in two motions: one motion for all standing and single nominations and a second motion for the Chair, Vice Chair, and competing seat nominations. Voting on the Chair, Vice Chair, and competing seat nominations were facilitated during the meeting via an electronic vote utilizing Microsoft Forms. Crysta also recognized retiring Council members and thanked them for their service. Glenn Barker (Corinth) asked for a motion to approve all standing and single nominations seats. James Gaertner (Waxahachie) made a motion to approve these nominations. Jody Byerly (Carrollton) seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Madisson Dunn (NCTCOG) shared the results of the electronic vote for the Chair, Vice Chair, and competing nomination seats:

- **Appointment of Bennett Howell (Benbrook) to Chair:** 94% in favor, 6% abstain

- **Appointment of Vice Chair:**
 - Matt Leppa (Weatherford): 50% of total vote
 - Layne Cline (Bedford): 25% of total vote
 - Abstain: 13% of total vote
 - Brad Harris (Balch Spring): 6% of total vote
 - Ahmed Alqaisi (DeSoto): 6% of total vote
- **Appointment of Mid-Cities Subregion seat:**
 - Boe Blankenship (North Richland Hills): 56% of total vote
 - Layne Cline (Bedford): 38% of total vote
 - Abstain: 6% of total vote
- **Appointment of Southwest Dallas Subregion seat:**
 - Andrew Waits (Glenn Heights): 69% of total vote
 - Ahmed Alqaisi (DeSoto): 25% of total vote
 - Abstain: 6% of total vote

Glenn Barker (Corinth) asked for a motion to approve the Chair, Vice Chair, and competing subregion voting results. Michael Owen (Fort Worth) made a motion to approve these votes. James Gaertner (Waxahachie) seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Crysta congratulated all appointees, the upcoming Vice Chair and Chair.

3. **Public Works Subcommittee Nominations.** The PWC will vote to approve the appointments for the Public Works subcommittees. (Madisson Dunn).

Madisson Dunn (NCTCOG) shared the nominations for each public works subcommittee. Glenn Barker (Corinth) asked for a motion to approve the subcommittee nominations. Bennett Howell (Benbrook) made a motion to approve the subcommittee nominations. Jody Byerly (Carrollton) seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

4. **Regional Public Works FY2027 Work Program.** The PWC will vote to approve the FY2027 Work Program. (Madisson Dunn)

Madisson Dunn (NCTCOG) provided an overview of the FY27 Work Program. Glenn Barker (Corinth) asked for a motion to approve the work program. James Gaertner (Waxahachie) made a motion to approve. Bennett Howell (Benbrook) seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

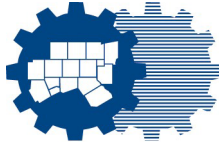
DISCUSSION ITEM

5. **Regional Public Works Council Bylaws.** NCTCOG will share the proposed recommendations to the Council Bylaws and invite members to provide input. (Madisson Dunn)

Madisson Dunn (NCTCOG) shared the draft Council Bylaws that incorporated recommendations from the Bylaws Subcommittee. Madisson asked the Council for any outstanding comments or concerns to consider for the Bylaws or subregion structure, as Bylaws are reviewed every five years. No additional comments or concerns were shared. The final draft Bylaws will be presented to Council before a future meeting to be voted on for approval.

6. **FY2026 Public Works Program Update.** The PWC will be updated on recent Public Works Program efforts and Subcommittee activities.



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Madisson Dunn (NCTCOG) shared an updated list of FY26 cost share participants and informed members that FY27 invoices will be sent in September/October.

- **PWC Marketing.** NCTCOG will share updates on marketing the PWC. (Crysta Guzman)

Crysta Guzman (NCTCOG) updated the Council that the PWC LinkedIn continues to operate as normal, and shared social media metrics for several posts. She mentioned that video posts gathered more engagement than static (picture) posts. Crysta elaborated that PWC members can help with engagement by reposting PWC's content.

- **Training.** NCTCOG will provide an update on the FY26 training. (Madisson Dunn)

Madisson Dunn (NCTCOG) provided a brief overview of the Asphalt training in July and opened discussion for any feedback regarding the training. Erik Ferner (Plano) stated that several Plano employees attended both trainings, and they felt the training was impactful and interesting – especially the asphalt plant tour. Madisson updated the Council on the New Construction Inspectors Training, tentatively scheduled for October 7, 2026, 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. in Carrollton, TX. Registration information will be distributed via email in the coming weeks. Breanna Davis (Duncanville) asked about the current contact information for their entity. Madisson stated to email mdunn@nctcog.org and she will review and update the contact information as needed.

- **Public Works Roundup.** NCTCOG will provide an update for the 27th Annual Public Works Roundup, scheduled for August 20, 2026, at the Hurst Conference Center. (Madisson Dunn)

Madisson Dunn (NCTCOG) shared that the previously four approved amendments have been integrated in the Public Works Construction Standards and added to the [Standards webpage](#) (under the *2026 Annual Amendments* section). The approved amendments will be presented to the Executive Board during the August meeting. Madisson stated that the next electronic

review of the revision requests is scheduled for October 2026. Following the electronic distribution, subcommittee members will submit their comments and feedback to PublicWorks@nctcog.org by November 30, 2026. These comments and feedback will be aggregated and incorporated into the materials for the in-person March 10, 2026, meeting at 10:00 a.m.

- **Integrated Stormwater Management (iSWM) Subcommittee.** An update of iSWM program activities will be provided. (Katie Hunter)

Katie Hunter (NCTCOG) provided an overview of the last iSWM Subcommittee meeting, including FY26 work program updates, approval of FY27 work plan tasks, and discussion of the iSWM Subcommittee transition. - **National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP).** NCTCOG will provide an update on the National Flood Insurance Program. (Katie Hunter)

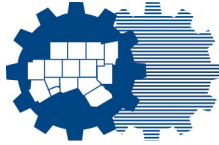
