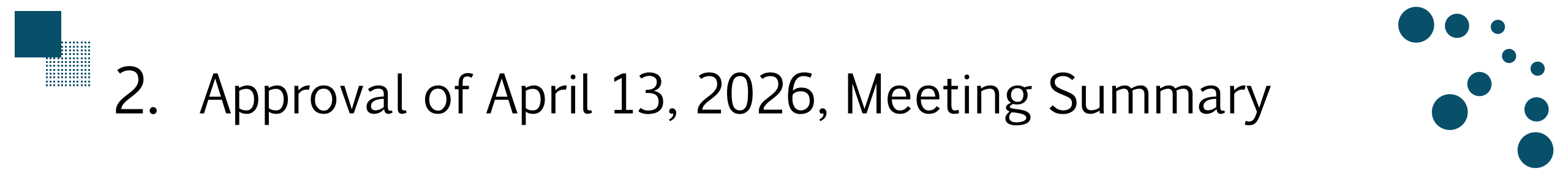

4. FY27 Work Program Task Item Prioritization Survey Results

Out of the 9 responses the highest-priority initiatives identified by survey respondents were:

- Update iSWM manuals and develop new technical guidance.
- Integrate Community Rating System (CRS) concepts and opportunities into iSWM efforts.
- Evaluate integration with the ISI Envision sustainability framework.
- Quantify the benefits and performance of LID practices designed to iSWM criteria.
- Conduct a comprehensive ("holistic") update of the iSWM Manual.



5 .Draft FY27 Work Plan Task Items

- A. Hold a workshop with engineers, landscape professionals, stormwater professionals, and others to identify and prioritize manual updates and revisions.
