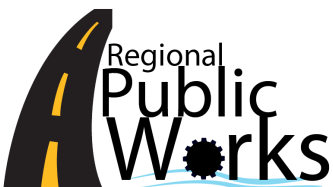
WHAT THE PROGRAM INCLUDES:
