

North Texas Zero Emissions Vehicles Call for Projects

Rebates to Replace Class 6 or Class 7 “vocational vehicles” with zero-emissions trucks

Both battery electric and hydrogen fuel cell electric trucks eligible

Can fund supporting charging/fueling infrastructure if needed

Both public and private sector fleets eligible

Old trucks may be scrapped OR sold/donated depending on age and fuel type

Example “vocational vehicles” include:

Straight/Box Truck



Step Van



Septic/Bucket Truck



Street Sweeper



Transit Bus



Refuse Hauler



Other Vocational Vehicles*

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*School bus eligible only if NOT operated as a typical school bus as defined in Guidelines Appendix A

Eligible Funding Levels

Funding limited by cost share percentage or dollar funding cap, whichever is lower

Funding can be applied to infrastructure if the cost share % is the limiting factor

Based on difference between dollar funding cap and incentive allowed by cost share percentage

e.g. a \$200K box truck qualifies for \$130K based on cost share; leaves \$60K for infrastructure

NORTH TEXAS ZERO EMISSIONS VEHICLES CALL FOR PROJECTS

Up to \$55.4 million is available for fleets to replace existing heavy-duty vehicles with zero-emission vehicles

Applications are due every 3rd Friday of the month at 5 PM CT, until funds are exhausted

Eligible Projects: Replacement of existing Class 6 and 7 vocational vehicles operating primarily in the NCTCOG region with battery-electric or hydrogen fuel cell electric vehicles

- Vocational vehicles can include Step Vans, Box Trucks, Street Sweepers, Bucket Trucks, Refuse Haulers, Transit Buses, Dump Trucks, and more

Eligible Applicants: Public or private fleets

Funding Level: Up to 33% to 80% of the new vehicle price
