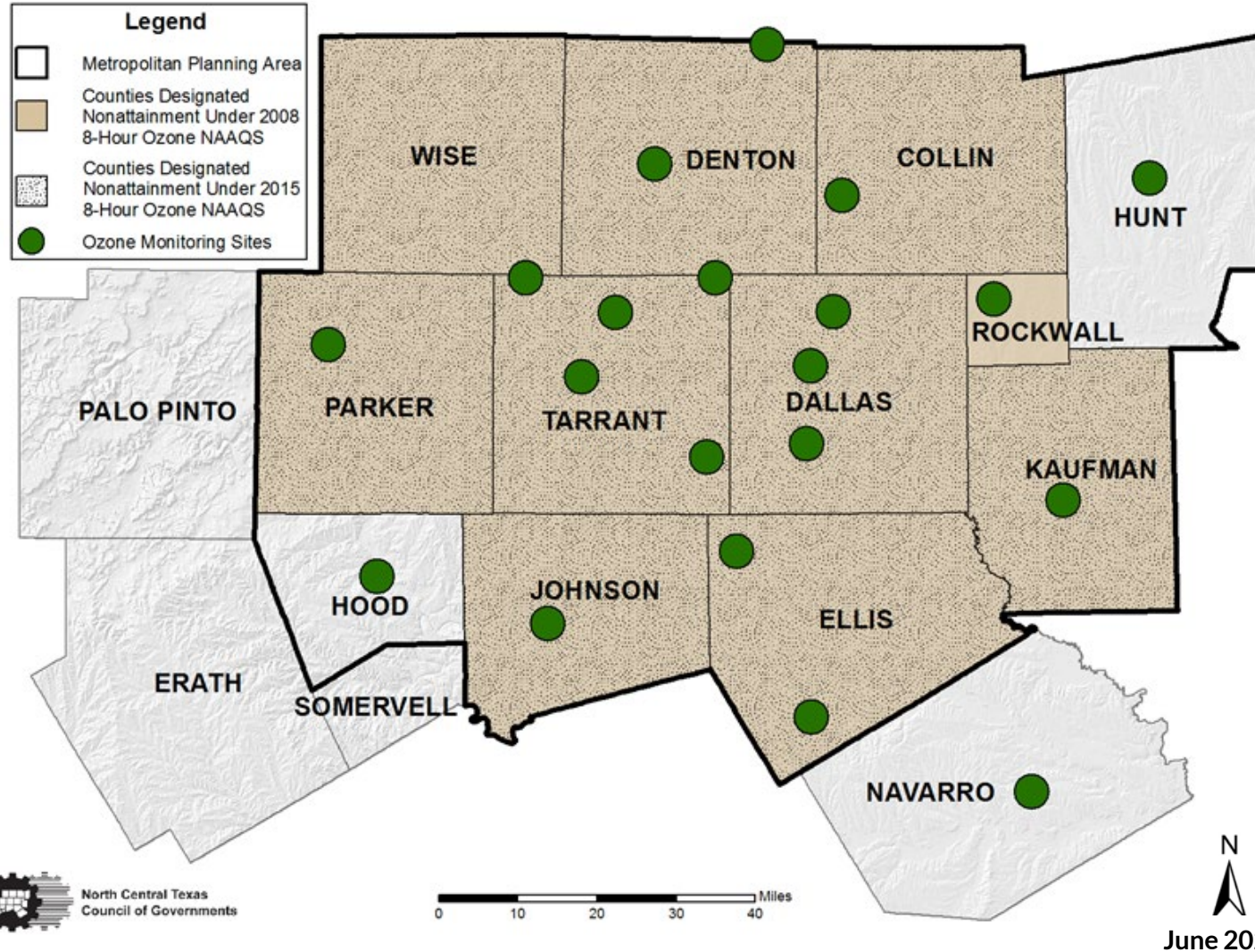

TRANSPORTATION CONFORMITY

Purpose:

Federal requirement in nonattainment areas to conduct air quality analysis on projects, programs, and policies identified in transportation plans, transportation improvement programs, federally funded projects, or projects required for federal approval

Applies to:

Long-Range Metropolitan Transportation Plans and
Transportation Improvement Programs

TIMELINE

June 12, 2025: RTC Approval (Consultation Partners' Approval on Pre-Analysis Pending)

August 12, 2025: Documentation Submittal to Consultation Partners (Pre-Analysis Approved)

October 22, 2025 – April 3, 2026: Consultation Partners' Comments Received and Addressed

April 28, 2026: Consultation Partners' Concurrence Letters Received

April 30, 2026: U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) Determination Letter Received

2025 TRANSPORTATION CONFORMITY DETERMINATION

Applies to Mobility 2050 and 2025–2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Restarts four-year time clock for the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) – April 30, 2030

Satisfies the following requirements

Demonstrates that projected emissions from transportation projects are within emission limits (Motor Vehicle Emissions Budgets) for NO_x and VOC established by the State Implementation Plan (SIP)

Ensures federal funding and approval is applied to transportation projects that are consistent with air quality planning goals

Ensures that transportation control measures in approved SIPs are given priority for federal funding

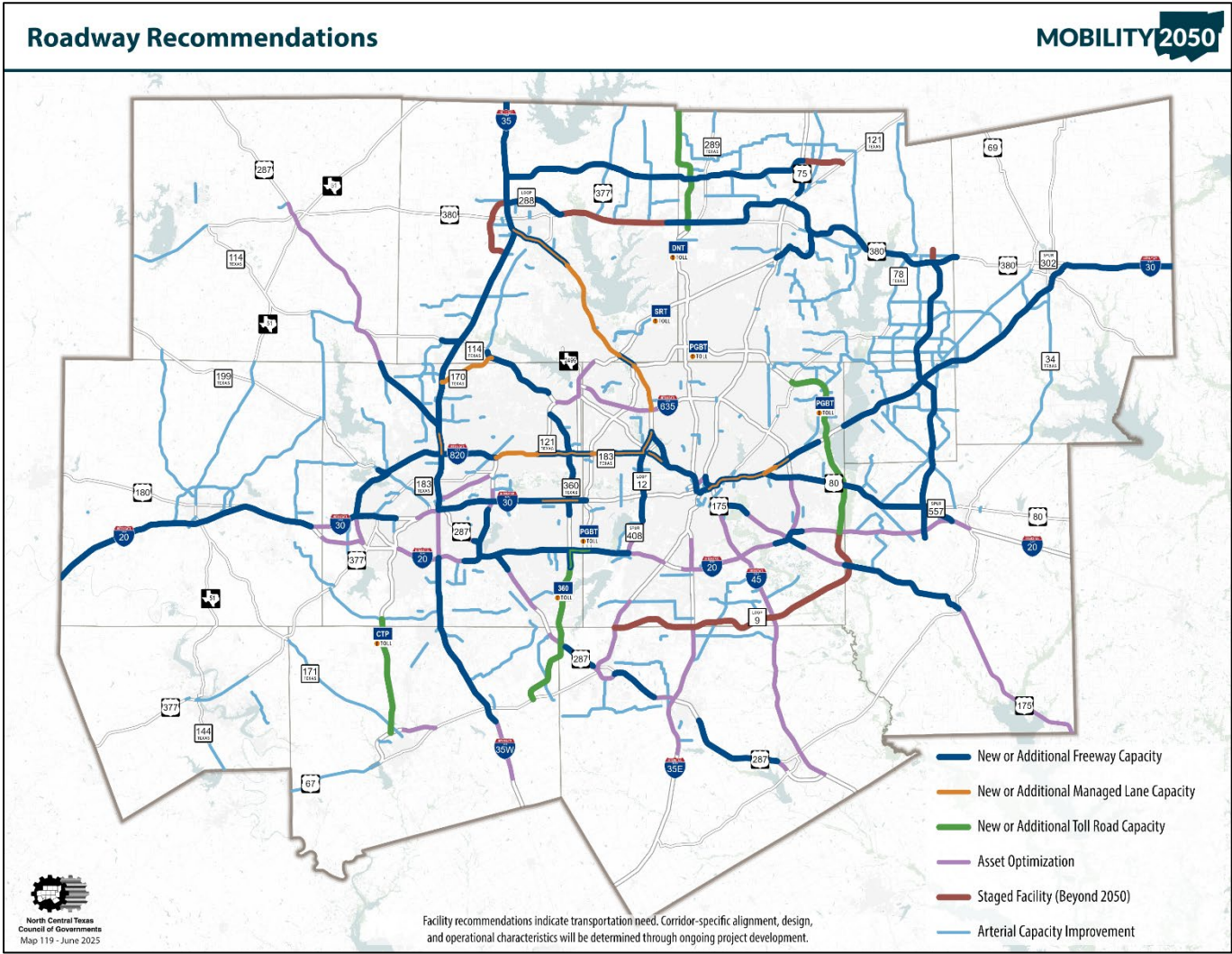
CONFORMITY ACHIEVED

Conformity Review:

- **Ensuring Consistency:** MTP recommendations consistent with TIP and Conformity networks
- **Editorial Refinements:** Project corrections to costs, limits, lanes, and tables for Conformity Review
- **No major changes:** Minor refinements to roadway tables and networks
