- 3. Update on the 89th Texas Legislative Session.** NCTCOG will present an update on relevant legislative bills tracked or passed during the 89th Texas Legislative Regular Session.

NCTCOG provided an update on the current bills up for consideration, and it was noted that HB517 (relating to watering restrictions, landscaping/vegetations, and HOA's) had been signed by the governor.

- 4. FY26 RSWMCC Appointments and Reappointments.** NCTCOG will provide an overview of the appointment and election process for the Watershed Representatives and Vice Chair to the Regional Stormwater Management Coordinating Council for the FY2026-2028 term, beginning October 1, 2025.

NCTCOG presented an update on the status of voting for the open positions on the RSWMCC. The Vice Chair position, as well as a single seat in each watershed are up for appointment.

Voting will be held electronically.

Additionally, the “Work Program Committee” was reinstated at the May RSWMCC meeting. NCTCOG will solicit volunteers from the RSWMCC Task Force to serve in FY26.

- 5. Appointment of Task Force to Review RSWMCC Committee Procedures and Work Plan.** NCTCOG staff will present the appointment of the Ad Hoc Committee and the next steps for the review of RSWMCC Committee Procedures and Work Plan.

On July 16, 2025, an Ad Hoc Task Force for Review of RSWMCC Committee Procedures and Work Plan was appointed by the RSWMCC Chair, Perry Harts, City of Frisco.

The Task Force is comprised of volunteers from the RSWMCC membership. The desired outcome of the Ad Hoc Task Force is to prepare updates to the Committee Procedures and FY26 Work Program that will be presented at the November 12, 2025 RSWMCC Meeting.

- 6. FY26 Work Program.** NCTCOG staff will present the status and timeline for the development and approval of the FY26 Work Program.

The Draft FY26 Work Program is under development and review by the Ad Hoc Review Committee. It will be presented for a vote at the November RSWMCC Meeting.

At the start of FY26, NCTCOG staff will be coordinating cost shares and facilitating Ad Hoc Committee until the approval of the FY26 Work Program.

- 7. FY26 Work Program Committee.** NCTCOG staff will present the status of the Work Program Committee which will be reinstated in FY26.

NCTCOG will also look to facilitate the Work Program Committee with Task Force volunteers in FY26.

- The Cost Share for FY25 is 101% funded as of August 20, 2025.
- In FY26, all Cost Share invoices will be delivered electronically.
- **Public Education Task Force**
 - Doo the Right Thing social media photo contest and campaign will conclude public voting on August 30th, 2025. Winners and other content will be posted on the social media platform in FY26.
 - The 2025 March is Texas SmartScape Month Campaign online traffic peaked on April 12th, 2025 with 621 views and 204 visitors. Additionally, updates and content fixes have been ongoing to the Texas SmartScape Pinterest account. Planning for next years campaign will begin in FY26.
 - The North Texas Community Cleanup Challenge 2025 Final leaderboard update will be made available soon.
- **Pollution Prevention Roundtable**
 - Upcoming projects include continuation of Municipal Pollution Prevention BMP Posters. NCTCOG Staff coordinating BMP “Show and Tell” roundtable event.
- **Illicit Discharge Detection & Elimination Roundtable**
 - Hosted Fish Kill Workshop at City of Carrollton on June 18, 2025.
 - Dry Weather Screening Workshop to be hosted, TBD September 2025.
 - Special project for FY25 will be finishing updates to the Yard Waste Door Hangar template which will be available for customization in Canva.
- **Stormwater Monitoring Program**
 - Last update received from TCEQ on approval of Fifth Term Proposal was received in March 2025.

City of Mansfield – Have not heard back regarding their NOI from TCEQ. Have had 2 West Nile hits with traps in the last few weeks.

City of Mesquite – Permit has still not been approved. Have done all public notices. Collaborating with other departments on what is needed for the Pesticide General Permit.

City of Plano – Heard back from the state about MS4 permit submitted in 2020. Received a draft about 6 months ago and received notice to provide feedback in several weeks. Have hired two new employees and hope for another position to be approved.

City of Carrollton – Have not received notification on the MS4 permit. Looking for a new water conservation staff member.

City of Dallas – Finishing up biological sampling program for the year.

City of Irving – Just finished dry weather field screens, with not many illicit discharges this year.

City of Fort Worth – Still waiting to hear back regarding MS4 permit. Will be hosting a construction workshop for city operators teaching internal staff on their requirements.

City of Burleson – Received NOI yesterday. There may be a push to have as many done by September 1st, 2025, as possible. Date you receive approval will be the last date of the old permit. Had 15 positive cases for West Nile this year so doing testing with the state.

NTTA – Draft MS4 permit has been approved, and waiting for information needed to do the final public notification.

City of Richardson – Have not heard back on MS4 permit.

City of Denton – Has a new stormwater management plan. Have also had positives from West Nile traps.

City of Frisco – Participating in National Stormwater Week again and will have the mayor read a proclamation this year.
