The Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) has reviewed the final Transportation Conformity documentation for the Mobility 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan and 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program as developed by the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG). TXDOT submitted comments to NCTCOG during the conformity review process in accordance with the interagency consultation procedures outlined in 40 CFR 93.105 and 30 TAC 114.260. Those comments were addressed by NCTCOG, and TXDOT verified that the 2025 Transportation Conformity for Mobility 2050 is consistent with the approved Pre-Analysis Consensus Plan (PACP). The Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) and Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) are based on the latest planning assumptions. The conformity analysis was developed using the latest approved emissions models and is consistent with applicable motor vehicle emissions budgets established in the State Implementation Plan.

Based on the information received through the review process, TXDOT has completed our review. Pending concurrence from the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA), the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), we support a positive conformity finding.
