- 4. Regional Codes Work Program Discussion.** NCTCOG will update the RCCC on the current funding status for the FY2024 Work Program and other applicable items.

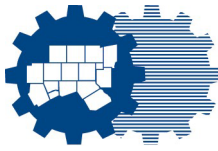

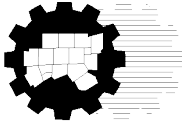
