FY23 Project Discussion

Received Suggestions:

- Theme: Staff Training and Record Keeping
 - Didn't write it down? Didn't happen. Keep training records where you can find them.
- Theme: Pesticides and Herbicides
 - Is it raining? I'm not spraying! Never schedule pesticide applications when precipitation or high wind conditions are forecast.

• Staff Suggestions:

- Theme: Leak and Spill Cleanup
 - Do you know what to do in the event of a spill? Make sure you know where to locate containment kits and how to properly cleanup and dispose of items in your yard/shop following the recommendations in the MSDS.
- Theme: Material Storage
 - Storing materials in sealed, original containers indoors is always a best practice. If storage outside is necessary, opt for a covered and paved area and inspect regularly for corrosion or signs of leaks.


