WHEREAS, the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) is a Texas political subdivision and non-profit corporation organized and operating under Texas Local Government Code Chapter 391 as the regional planning commission for the 16-county North Central Texas region; and,

WHEREAS, NCTCOG is a voluntary association of, by and for local governments established to assist in planning for common needs, cooperating for mutual benefit, and coordinating for sound regional development; and,

WHEREAS, NCTCOG has been designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolitan Area by the Governor of the State of Texas in accordance with federal law; and,

WHEREAS, the Regional Transportation Council (RTC) serves as the MPO policy committee, comprised primarily of local elected officials, and is the regional transportation policy body associated with NCTCOG, and has been and continues to be a forum for cooperative decisions on transportation; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Dallas-Fort Worth region is in nonattainment of the federal air quality standard for ozone and may soon enter into nonattainment for fine particulate matter ( $PM_{2.5}$ ) and NCTCOG is actively involved in the development and implementation of the State Implementation Plan for air quality; and,

WHEREAS, the RTC is committed to the development and implementation of policies, projects, and programs to improve air quality and reduce emissions that create ozone; and,

WHEREAS, Subtask 3.03 of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 and FY2027 Unified Planning Work Program for Regional Transportation Planning includes implementation of initiatives that improve air quality; and,

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2024, the Executive Board approved submittal of a grant application by NCTCOG on behalf of the region to the Environmental Protection Agency's Clean Heavy-Duty Vehicles (CHDV) Program to replace existing heavy-duty internal combustion vocational vehicles with zero-emission vehicles, install supporting infrastructure, and complete workforce development and training activities; and.

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency has awarded \$60 million in federal funding to NCTCOG under the Environmental Protection Agency's Clean Heavy-Duty Vehicles Program through the North Texas Zero Emission Vehicle Project; and,

WHEREAS, NCTCOG will initiate a Call for Projects to award rebates to replace eligible existing Class 6 and 7 vocational vehicles with zero-emission vehicles; and,
