

Key Focus Based on Timeline

Sheltering

- Provide a safe sanitary and secure locations
- Provide food, water, and information
- Provide access to disaster assistance

Temporary/Transitional Housing

- Support immediate recovery needs (e.g., reunification, food, shelter)
- Begin repairs and reconstruction


Permanent Housing

Develop a long-term Recovery Strategy to build back better
