On November 6 (Texas Arbor Day weekend), over 100 volunteers gathered on the banks of Wilson Creek in McKinney to plant trees in the name of protecting water quality and improving the environment. Over 1,600 native trees were planted to reduce erosion and mitigate impacts of stormwater runoff into Lavon Lake, the primary source of water for 2 million North Texans. The project resulted in public/private partnerships between many NGOs and agencies and was made possible by support from the Bonneville Environmental Foundation Change the Course campaign, with contributions from Coors Seltzer.
