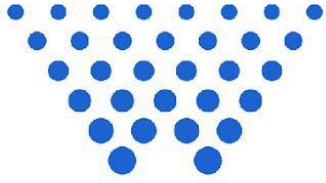

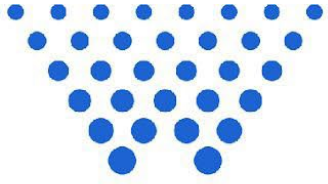

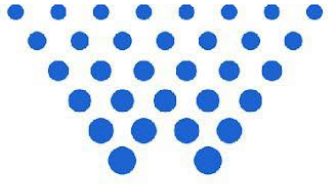


# What is InFLOW?

It was conceived by our parent organization, Water Environment Federation (WEF) in an effort to introduce promising students from underrepresented groups who are interested in professional careers in the water industry



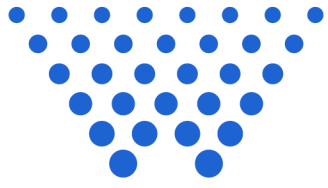


# InFLOW at Texas Water
