3. Special Presentation.

Susan Alvarez with the City of Dallas provided a PowerPoint and presentation on the update to the City of Dallas design manuals to include iSWM and Complete Streets practices, and the incorporation of design standards in the 2017 Bond Program. Ms. Alvarez said she expects the new Street Drainage Manual to be complete prior to the 2017 Bond Program. She also mentioned the City of Dallas may be revising the Stormwater Utilities Fee by using a GIS assessment.

4. Regional Public Works Program Update.

NCTCOG staff provided an update on the FY16 Regional Public Works Program. The Public Works Roundup on June 8th at Brookhaven College still has registration open.

There were 62 registrants and 35 attendees for the Education Forum, which was a great turnout. Of the 23 evaluation forms turned in, the responses were most often Good or Excellent, and the most useful part of the forum was the ADA Presentation by Accessology. The attendees' suggestions for future Education Forums included: a wider variety of topics, and some said the presentations were too fast for note taking.

The subcommittee suggested future topics include the City of Dallas' iSWM and Complete Streets program that Sue Alvarez presented.

6. Other SPROW Activities.

The NCTCOG staff provided an update and asked for feedback on the SPROW Roadmap. NCTCOG staff noted that some links are only accessible through Internet Explorer.

There was then a lengthy discussion on whether to continue to have the Roadmap updated and available to the public. Some members felt it was not a tool many would use. Instead, the group agreed, they should focus on the Education Forums.

Furthermore, the group discussed the possibility of completely disbanding the committee due to lack of participation and lack of pertinent topics.

7. Transportation Department Activities.

NCTCOG Transportation staff, Kristina Ronneberg, presented on a new technology that incorporates solar and wind energy into powering street lights.

8. Roundtable Discussion.


Chair Rachel Hayden resigned from her position. NCTCOG staff said they will issue an invitation for a new chair.


