3. FY 2026 Trinity River COMMON VISION Work Program Activities Discussion.

- a. **NFIP and CDC Model Consolidation Team.** NCTCOG staff will update the FMTF on scopes of work and next steps related to the consolidated NFIP-CDC model and maintenance process. (Emilie Fryksater, CFM, NCTCOG)
 - i. **CDC Model Files Updated.** The most recently updated NFIP-CDC Consolidated Model files have been uploaded to the NCTCOG site.
 - ii. **CDC Expansion – TSI Project Area.** NCTCOG will introduce preliminary efforts in identifying opportunities to expand the Corridor Development Certificate Program into the TSI Project area.
- b. **East Fork/Denton Creek Update and Expansion of the CDC Program West.** NCTCOG staff will inform the FMTF on relaunch of outreach efforts and initiatives to bring additional communities into the Common Vision program. (Emilie Fryksater)
