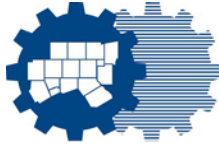
INFORMATION ITEMS

OTHER BUSINESS AND ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION

9. Future Agenda Items. RSWMCC Members and NCTCOG staff may suggest future agenda items.

Krista, City of Carrollton, would like to revisit the topic of in-person meetings and see if we can have more than one per year. Members from the cities of Mansfield, Irving, Mesquite, Grand Prairie, and others support having more in-person meetings. Other members from Lewisville, Prosper, Southlake, Waxahachie, and Denton support in-person meetings but would like to see an option for attending online offered alongside the in-person meetings. It was requested to consider making the February 21st meeting in-person instead of virtual as the group will be voting on updates to the cost shares.

At the February meeting, the group may discuss a new date for the meeting in May due to a conflict with the TCEQ Environmental Trade Fair.

Members would like to have a discussion on the new Small MS4 Permit requirements once it is released.

10. Roundtable Discussion. Discussion of activities within individual jurisdictions as time allows.

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Carrollton: working on annual report and thinking about the new permit. Stormdrain contest is open to anyone in the region if anyone wants to enter. Link for contest is here: <https://www.cityofcarrollton.com/departments/departments-a-f/environmental-quality/stormwater/storm-drain-art-contest> . Did receive final approval on 2019 permit

Irving: Working on annual report; stormwater master plan; waiting on rain to see how things are operating. Changes in organization at Irving. Also feel that StormCon in Dallas was a little underwhelming.

Mesquite: Still learning and working with a consultant on their stormwater permit. Waiting to hear back from TCEQ on the permit; answered a question in August but have heard nothing since then.

Fort Worth: The City of Fort Worth Bandalong was installed at Lake Como September 15, 2023. More Watergoats are scheduled to be installed Dec 2023. Members can contact Nixalis for more information. Waterwheel Mooring and Piling Bids going live Nov 16.

Southlake: Just kicked off the Holiday Grease Roundup. The 2019 Permit was finally approved a month ago. Working on the Annual Report for FY23 now.

Prosper: Recently hired first full time Erosion Control Inspector. In September, had a 5-year audit with TCEQ with zero violations. Received the 2019 SWMP document back with edits from TCEQ and a few things were asked to fixed. Getting ready to put that in the newspaper.

DFW Airport: Passed an audit by TCEQ and working on reporting.

City of Waxahachie: Have a Creek Stabilization project that is under construction on Waxahachie Creek. Preparing an updated Engineering RFQ for a new creek stabilization project further upstream.

Lewisville: Preparing to be overwhelmed by the last annual report and new SWMP at the same time. Still have not received the final permit approval for the current permit term so will likely end the permit term without one. Feel that the Dallas StormCon was a little underwhelming.

Denton: The 2019 MS4 Permit was approved in September.

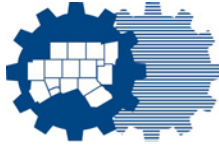
DART: Getting ready for the Annual Report and working on the new MS4 SWMP.

Richardson: Had their permit approved and public notice was posted on Monday. Working on the annual report and thinking of the new permit.

Allen: Still have not received approval of the 2019 permit yet. Started working on water conservation now as part of their group at the city.

Jeff Haynes motioned to adjourn, Julian Holmes seconded the motion.



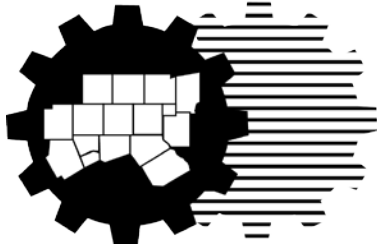

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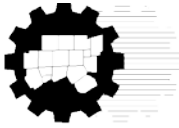
