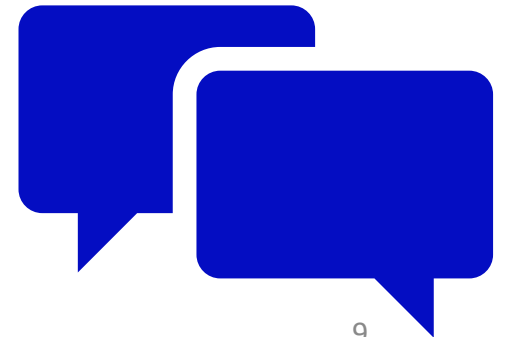

Yard Waste Educational Door Hangar Template

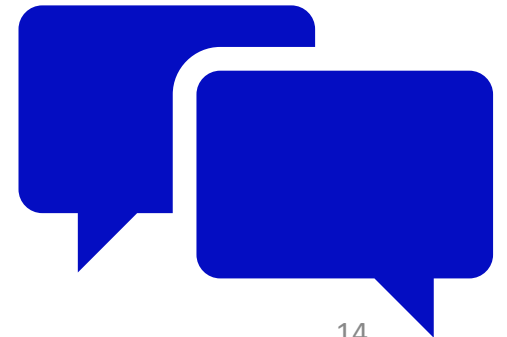
- Door Hangar for yard waste education was developed with Assistance from City of Carrollton and is available for review.

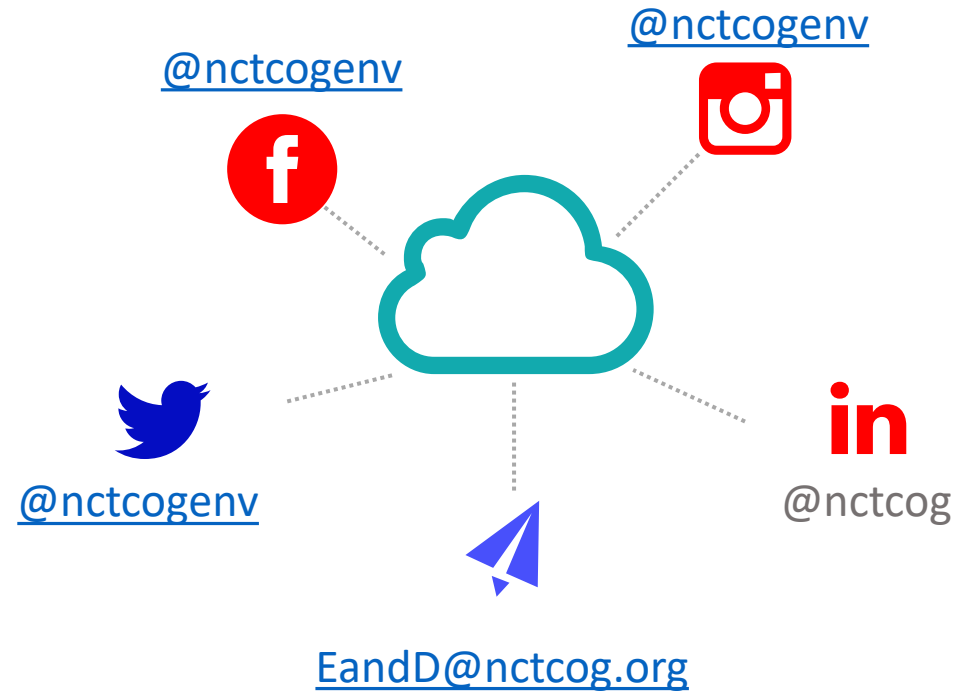
