1. Welcome and Introductions.

ACTION ITEMS

2. **Meeting Summary**. The October 8, 2015 meeting summary is available online for your review. Approval will be sought at the meeting.

Vance Kemler made a motion to approve the October 8, 2015 meeting summary, and Brenda Haney seconded the motion. The Resource Conservation Council was unanimous in its approval.

3. Conformance Review Determination: Southwaste Disposal, LLC, Type V Liquid Waste Processing Facility, TCEQ Permit No. MSW 2256A. Consultant group was Biggs & Mathews Consulting Engineers, Mansfield, TX: Vance Kemler, Chair of the Assuring Capacity for Trash (ACT) Subcommittee, will present the ACT's recommendation for RCC approval.

Vance Kemler reported that the Southwaste Disposal, LLC, Type V Liquid Waste Processing Facility, TCEQ Permit No. MSW 2256A is in conformance with the Planning for Sustainable Materials Management in North Central Texas Plan and the request for major amendment authorization was approved by the Assuring Capacity for Trash (ACT) Subcommittee. The ACT recommended the Amendment for approval. Vance Kemler made a motion to approve, and Brenda Haney seconded the motion.

4. FY2016-2017 Materials Management Call for Projects Results and recommendation to the NCTCOG Executive Board. Staff will update RCC members on the status of the FY2016-2017 Materials Management Call for Projects. The results of the grant selection process for the applications received will be presented to the RCC for consideration and approval. A motion to recommend to the NCTCOG Executive Board will be sought.



North Central Texas Council of Governments

The RCC members voted to approve the 14 recommended FY16/17 Materials Management Grant Projects. Approval will now be sought from the NCTCOG Executive Board at the February 25, 2016 Executive Board meeting. Vance Kemler made a motion to approve, and Robert Smouse seconded the motion. Robert Berndt opposed.

The following suggestions were made regarding the remaining implementation funds:

- Steve Massey, the RCC Chair suggested the remaining implementation funds be used to purchase bags for distribution to local governments for litter clean-up events with NCTCOG distributing the bags.
- Vance Kemler suggested the remaining funds should be used to provide a workshop to educate local governments about large venue event recycling.
- Vance Kemler also suggested the remaining funds be used to purchase Single Stream Containers and allow local governments to borrow the containers for large venue events then return to NCTCOG for others to use.

Mr. Massey suggested that the group hold out for further suggestions to be submitted to NCTCOG staff and discuss the suggestions/ideas at the next upcoming meeting or take a vote electronically.

DISCUSSION

5. **Proposed regional NCTCOG Managed Drug Take Back Pilot Project.** Two members of the RCC have proposed a regional project and will bring forth the project topic for discussion with the entire RCC for consideration and possible approval.

RCC member Kathy Fonville suggested that the remaining implementation funds be used to pay for a regional drug take-back pilot project. The RCC members asked what can be done now or long term in regards to addressing drug take-back. Discussion of this topic produced the idea of offering a 'Regional Drug Take-Back Workshop' and discussion regarding who would bare the cost of the mailing envelopes for drug take-back. RCC members stated that additional grant funds should be sought or the local governments could share the costs. Kathy Fonville suggests that the idea be vetted further and be brought back for further consideration.

6. **Future Committee Structure.** Discussion among the committee to determine how the group would like to be structured moving forward.

RCC members made the following committee structure suggestions:

The first suggestion made by members of the RCC is to allow others to evaluate that are not on the RCC as a member or alternate and consider having a committee address Product Stewardship items for the region. Other suggestions were made such as Standing Committees; Re-name the TTR/ACT/SID Subcommittees; Planning for Sustainable Materials Management Plan (tasks to be divided into smaller subcommittees); and make



(TTR/ACT/SID) as subsets (subcommittees) to the Regional Solid Waste Management Plan to address their expertise within their subcommittee is important.


The RCC made a request to change the April 21, 2016 RCC meeting date to April 19, 2016.


