1. Welcome and introductions.

The meeting began at 9:30 a.m. with introductions of all present.

2. **Meeting Summary.** The April 13, 2017, meeting summary is available online for review. Comments will be sought at the meeting. (Mia Brown)

The meeting summary was reviewed and one correction was requested. The summary was accepted pending the change.

3. **FY 2017 Training Discussion.** NCTCOG staff will solicit feedback on completed FY 2017 Dry Weather Field Screening Basic, Intermediate, and Advanced Training. (Mia Brown)

Mia Brown shared the feedback received from evaluation forms for the Basic and Intermediate/Advanced Trainings. The most frequently noted “wants” for Basic training were to see the kits in action and for everyone to get the opportunity to sample at the outfall, and the “change” was to have more requirements for participation. The most useful portion of the training was the kit comparisons and use, and the permit requirements. The location in Carrollton was very desirable. The most frequently noted “wants” for the Intermediate/Advanced training were tips for using GIS effectively, more hands-on/field activities, problem solving sessions, and to split the training into two days. The most useful portions of the training were the flow charts, learning about other cities’ challenges, case studies, and the use of dyes and optical brighteners.

- a. Randy Cochran, Stormwater Hydrologist – City of Frisco, will present a case study entitled “Identifying and Sourcing Wastewater Effluence in Groundwater Discharges.”

Randy Cochran presented a case study about the discovery of wastewater effluent in a neighborhood in Frisco and the subsequent investigation.

The City of Irving is beginning dry weather field screening for the summer.


The City of Cedar Hill is currently working on dry weather field screening.


