Justin Cox, NCTCOG

- SHSP Grants Dashboard
 - Grants Dashboard – most of the projects have been completed. We are ensuring all invoices have been submitted. SWAT have completed the projects; we are waiting for reimbursement. Once we receive reimbursement, the dashboard will be updated. There will be very little money going back to the state. More updates will be provided at the next meeting.

Information Items (10:30 AM)

- SERI Grant (Statewide Emergency Radio Infrastructure)
 - This is for radio infrastructure (no handheld radios).
 - This is a state program that is not tied into DHS.
 - This program will be offered in January and will close in March of 2024.
 - Estimated \$20 million in funds available.

Justin Cox, NCTCOG

- The only two entities that are eligible for this grant are COG's and state agencies.
- For COG to properly administer the grant, the following rules apply:
 - Will need to sign an ILA stating that the applying jurisdiction will pay for all items up-front, and then submit for reimbursement through COG.
 - You have not entered into any contract prior to being awarded.
 - The minimum project amount is \$500K. We will probably have project caps expected this year.
- Once Grant Guidance is released, we will send it out to the listserv.
- State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP) Justin Cox, NCTCOG
 - Texas is being allocated \$40 million over four years.
 - There is a match requirement that starts at 10% in FY22, and then goes up by 10% every year after.
 - Local jurisdictions, community colleges, and ISD's are eligible applicants.
 - Expecting guidance from OOG in Jan/Feb.
- Mitigation Planning Funding Alyana Payne, NCTCOG
 - The Texas General Land Office has a Local Hazardous Mitigation Plans Program
 - The COG is not the grant administrator of this program, but your jurisdiction can apply.
 - It is a \$25 million Hazardous Mitigation Plans program.
 - Utilizing this grant can help cover any required local cost share.
 - The LHMPP is a reimbursement program. The jurisdiction pays out-of-pocket, and then requests reimbursement.
 - To be reimbursed, the awardee must submit deliverables and all associated invoices to GLO.
 - You must be a local government entity to apply.
 - You must be current with any Federal debt.
 - You must be a Federal declared county.

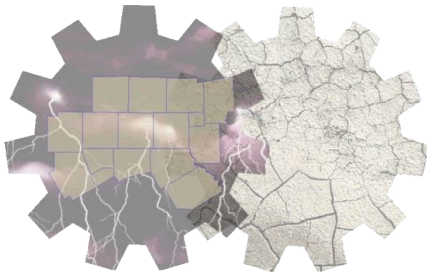
