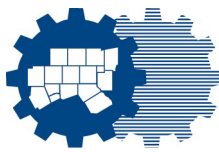

 - ii. Creating the CDC future flows for the FEMA detailed study on the East Fork Trinity and the Trinity mainstem to extend the consolidated model. Projected posting for the updated model will be best available data (not yet FEMA effective); estimated to be posted in Fall 2022.
