1. Welcome and Introductions.

## PRESENTATION

2. Mike Friesen, Assistant Deputy – Solid Waste, North Texas Municipal Water District (NTMWD), and Charles Marsh, P.E., Project Director, Weaver Consultants Group, LLC, will brief the Subcommittee on the Type V permit amendment application for the NTMWD Parkway Transfer Station, in Plano, Texas.

Mr. Friesen noted that the facility has been operational since 1984. The proposed amendments to the facility include increasing the capacity from 770 to 1500 tons per day, and adding a top-loading tunnel and a stormwater detention pond. There will be no changes to the permit boundary or access point.

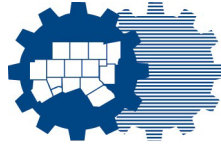
There are no significant impacts to traffic patterns anticipated within one mile of the facility due to the proposed changes. Land use within two miles of the facility boundary is mostly residential.

## ACTION ITEM

3. The Subcommittee will discuss the Type V permit amendment application for the NTMWD Parkway Transfer Station, and vote whether to recommend to the Resource Conservation Council (RCC) that the application conforms to the North Central Texas Regional Solid Waste Management Plan.

There was one question from the Subcommittee:

- 1) What is the proposed change in throughput at the facility?

The throughput is proposed to increase from 770 tons per day to 1500 tons per day. The applicant does not anticipate a large increase in trash volumes at the facility, but is asking for the increase in capacity for flexibility when transporting trash.

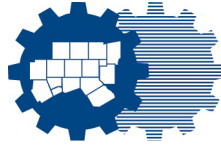
Risa Weinberger, Risa Weinberger & Associates, Inc., made a motion to recommend to the Resources Conservation Council that the major permit amendment application for the NTMWD Parkway Transfer Station conforms to the North Central Texas Regional Solid Waste Management Plan. Ami Reeder, City of Denton, seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Next Steps – The RCC will vote to approve the Subcommittee’s conformance recommendation for the NTMWD Parkway Transfer Station at its next meeting on Tuesday, February 14, 2023. After this meeting, a letter stating the RCC’s final conformance determination will be submitted to TCEQ, and a copy will also be sent to the applicant.
