3. FY 2022 Training.

NCTCOG staff will solicit input for FY 2022 training events:
The group discussed the possible format and schedule for FY 2022 training events.

a. Basic Dry Weather Field Screening Training

Discussion on seasonal preference of training, as well as format preference.

The preferred format was a hybrid training with both in-person and virtual sections, with recordings to be posted after the event. The consensus on seasonal preference was for Spring 2022, likely April or early May. The City of Irving has volunteered to host the training at their facility. It will require coordination with NCTCOG staff to determine what will be needed to accommodate a hybrid format. The City of Carrollton has volunteered to present as a Phase II City. There were no volunteers for Phase I City presentations. NCTCOG staff will send out a poll with the follow-up materials.

b. Industrial Inspectors Workshop

Discussion began with the group determining the annual schedule of the Industrial Inspectors Workshop. The trainings are generally held every other year, in even years. However, the Pandemic caused the training to get off schedule as the 2020 training was held in 2021. The group determined that the trainings should get back on the even years schedule, starting next year, 2022. There was an agreement amongst the group that the training should be held at a central location within the jurisdiction of one of the member cities. The City of Mansfield volunteered their household hazardous waste facility as a venue. The City of Dallas Stormwater Department volunteered to be one of the hosts/speakers as a Phase I City. There is a general preference for the training to be held in the fall.

Arlington – No updates

Carrollton – TCEQ has looked at SWMP, but not fully approved yet. Also looking for a Pre-Treatment Coordinator.

Cedar Hill – Recently had TCEQ audit their MS4. After the audit the SWMP was approved.

Dallas – Working on Annual Report, as it is due in December. In Permit Year 3 and don't have an approved SWMP yet. Water Quality Department is trying to get a jump on dry weather inspections. Have added new people to the Water Quality Team as they expand.

Denton – No updates

Fort Worth – No updates

Frisco – SWMP update from TCEQ in October. They asked for a couple corrections that they are waiting to hear back from.

Grand Prairie – No updates

Grapevine – No updates

Irving – The City of Irving currently has a hiring initiative because they are in dire need of employees throughout the city. They have an environmental compliance position open.

Lewisville – Recently annexed Castle Hills and in the process of incorporating that area into the SWMP. They will be going into a new phase since they are now over 100,000 population.

Mansfield – SWMP has completed technical review and admin review but has not been given notice to publish. Mansfield is currently growing at a ridiculous rate. Working on Annual Report as it is due in December.

Mesquite – No updates

Southlake – TCEQ approved new SWMP permit, but haven't received public notification instructions yet.

Tarrant County – Waiting on final approval of SWMP like many other entities. Mitchell Carpenter just recently started with Tarrant County as Robert Berdt retired before Thanksgiving. They are trying to fill Roberts old position now.

NTTA – Atkins has recently been selected as a representative of NTTA.
