COMMON VISION Work Program Overview and Activities Update.** NCTCOG staff will provide an overview of the Trinity River COMMON VISION Program, including the Corridor Development (CDC) Process and the CDC Model Consolidation efforts. An update will be provided on NCTCOG's COMMON VISION activities including the creation of an interactive GIS map of CDC applications, planning future Floodplain Management Seminars, NCTCOG's hosting of the 20<sup>th</sup> annual FEMA 4-day National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) course, and Tarrant Regional Water District (TRWD) Floodway Stakeholders meetings.

NCTCOG staff discussed updates on the CDC Program and USACE discussed the CDC consolidated model. The Steering Committee was notified of the upcoming 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) training course.

- 3. Approval of FY16 Trinity River COMMON VISION Work Program.** The Flood Management Task Force (FMTF) met on June 12<sup>th</sup> and assisted NCTCOG with the selection of work program items presented for the upcoming fiscal year. The FMTF then approved the work program composition on August 28<sup>th</sup> and recommended Trinity River COMMON VISION Steering Committee approval. The work program including the cost share breakout is attached.

The Steering Committee approved the work program.

- 4. Related Activities Update.** An update will be provided on related topics outside of this work program to include participation in FEMA's Cooperating Technical Partnership (CTP) Program and the formation of the North Texas Community Rating System (CRS) Users group. An update will also be provided on the acquisition of Atlas 14, a product which will compile and analyze historical precipitation data for the State of Texas.

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NCTCOG Staff provided an update on FEMA's CTP Program and the ongoing CRS Seminars. Jerry Cotter provided update on Atlas14

- 5. USACE Update on Continuing Authorities Program.** USACE staff will give an update on the Continuing Authorities Program to include streambank erosion protection, local flood damage reduction, aquatic ecosystem restoration, and environmental restoration.

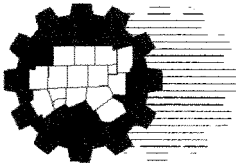
