1. Welcome and Introductions.

Subcommittee member and staff introductions.

2. Division 2000, 5000 and 6000 Review. The Subcommittee will provide last comments before Divisions 2000 and 6000 are sent to the Public Works Council for approval.

Subcommittee begins review of Division 2000. Edith Marvin (NCTCOG) is reviewing the table of contents and names of drawings. Chris Cha (Pacheco Koch) states that the dates need to be based on the Public Works Council adoption date. Edith states that she will present the amendments to the executive board of NCTCOG but will not ask them to adopt.

2010B and 2020B – Chris asks why the references are different (FHWA vs NACTO). Edith states that she will check with the transportation group of NCTCOG

2035 – Need to fix title in table of contents

2150C and 2150D – Chris asks if there used to be a drawing with a flaired, dustpan shape? Edith states that notes from January 2021 say to remove 2150D. Edith also states that we need to change rebar to 4 twice on bottom and once on top of drawings. Jason Heflin (NCTCOG) notes that those changes were already made in an AutoCAD drawing so he will print it off and insert it into the PDF.

2155A – Edith notes that there is a change to #4 bars required, Jason made the change in the AutoCAD drawing.

2170 – Edith states that a January note says to modify note 7 in the drawing re: 5-foot width. Jason notes that the change was made in an AutoCAD drawing and he will print it and add it to the PDF. Matthew Leppla (City of Weatherford) states that it would be helpful to add subgrade detail under the curb and gutter. Chris states that we can add a note stating to “Refer to roadway section for subgrade”. Chris then made the change in AutoCAD.

Subcommittee begins reviewing Division 5000.

5070 – Chris states that note should say “as required/requested” by owner. Jason made the change in AutoCAD for reprint.

3. **Division 4000 Review.** The Subcommittee will provide comments on Division 4000.

Subcommittee begins reviewing Division 4000. Jason states that the City of Lewisville doesn't allow combination systems similar to drawing 4150. Chris states that maybe no one allows the combined service. Jason will send the AutoCAD file to Chris and he will look at Coppell too.

4190AB – Jason confirms he got the AutoCAD files from Lewisville, Chris said he will update them in AutoCAD

Edith states that all dates need to be changed on drawings, Chris agrees

Chris asked where did we add information on casings? Jason searches the documents but doesn't find any information relating to casings.

Edith states that we need to change the title to drawing table of contents for drawing 4050 to match the title on the drawing itself to 12'

4100B – Table of contents title needs to match the drawing

Subcommittee notes that the table of contents item numbers frequently do not match what is reference in the drawing. Chris states that the 702 references the vault structure itself not the valve.

4200 – table of contents references wastewater, it should reference stormwater.

4. **Next Steps.** Subcommittee will outline next steps to be taken by NCTCOG staff and the group as a whole before the next meeting.

Subcommittee notes that page numbers on several drawings in Division 4000 need to be checked for accuracy. Chris is ok taking Divisions 2000, 5000 and 6000 to the Public Works Council meeting in February. He states that we can send everything except the 3 problematic drawings in division 4000 and let them know that we still need to review reference numbers and pages. Edith states that we should send these to the Public Works Council but also to the larger group through active campaign.

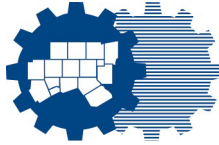
