EFFECTS OF IDLING



Idling wastes 6 billion gallons of fuel annually from heavy-duty and light-duty vehicles.¹



Personal vehicles contribute annually 30 million tons of carbon dioxide.¹



Manufacturers recommend driving off gently after no more than 30 seconds of idling.¹



Idling consumes fuel at a higher rate than while driving.²



Increased noise pollution.³



Contribute to air pollution, which can cause adverse health effects.



Some cities and counties may have idling restrictions which would make idling illegal.¹



THE RUN DOWN

(State Idling Rule)

Vehicles with a gross weight rating greater than 14,000 lbs. may not idle for more than 5 minutes (30 minutes for buses) in cities and counties that have adopted idling limitations set by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (30 Texas Administrative Code 114.512).

Check your city's ordinances or county's resolutions for exact idling restrictions in your area.

HOW DO I REPORT AN IDLING VEHICLE?

When making a report, please include the following information within 30 days of observing an idling heavy-duty vehicle.

- o Date Observed
- o Time of Day
- o City (where vehicle was observed idling)
- o Texas License Plate Number (specify Tractor or Trailer; Tractor preferred)
- o Type of Vehicle (bus, commercial truck or other)
- o Nearest Intersection
- o Company Name on Vehicle (if known)
