Regional Wet Weather Characterization Program (RWWCP)

- RWWCP is in the fifth year of the permit term.
- Continuing implementation of the Best Management Practices Analysis and Evaluation Plan (BANEP).
 - NCTCOG is working with Atkins on finalizing BMP data and Final Report. The deadline has been extended through November 30, 2022.
- NCTCOG staff is coordinating with TCEQ on the continuation of the program into a new permit term. NCTCOG staff is also developing RFP for new permit term.
