
Military Installation Resilience

Likely Location: Western Tarrant County

RFP Release Schedule: Early 2026

Scope (preliminary): identification of resilience issues, recommended remedies, and prioritization of projects (including cost estimates and potential funding sources) related to stormwater in the Farmers Branch Creek as it impacts communities west of NAS JRB Fort Worth, the base itself and communities east of the base; water service; energy service; cyber security; community resources such as first responders and recreation centers; stormwater debris mitigation; base accessibility; and transportation project construction traffic management plans.

Expertise Needed: Urban/Regional Planning, Engineering, Cyber Security, Public Utilities Planning and Engineering, Economic Analysis, Stakeholder Engagement, Tabletop Exercises, Meeting Facilitation



Crossing Students Safely in the Dallas-Fort Worth Region (CroSS-DFW)


Likely Location:

 ~200-300 K-8 school zones near high-injury corridors identified in the NCTCOG Pedestrian Safety Action Plan (RSAP) and Roadway Safety Plan (RSP) or in rural areas

RFP Release Schedule: Winter 2025-2026

Crossing Students Safely in the Dallas-Fort Worth Region (CroSS-DFW)

Scope (preliminary):

- School zone safety existing conditions analysis and data collection
- School/ISD/city outreach
- Develop crossing guard implementation process and recommendations
- Develop school zone safety best practices/recommendations
- Develop and implement demonstration of technology application for driver awareness in school zones

Expertise Needed: Planning, Outreach

Trinity Railway Express (TRE) Transit-Oriented Development Strategic Plan

<u>Likely Location</u>: Approximately the half-mile radius around seven TRE Stations' in Fort Worth, Irving, and Dallas

RFP Release Schedule: Tentatively, first or second quarter of 2026

Scope (preliminary):

- 1. Study and plan for improved pedestrian and bicycle connection to stations.
- 2. Market study and land use redevelopment plan to increase density, economic development, within the context of each station.
- 3. Guidance for using federal funding and loans and public/private partnership for TOD.

Public engagement is TBD pending input from cities ,DART, and Trinity Metro.

Some of the tasks may be partially or completely done in-house by NCTCOG staff.

Expertise Needed: Planning, Market Studies, Public engagement, Engineering(TBD) Anticipated DBE Goal: 30.9%



White Settlement Road Feasibility Study


Likely Location: City of White Settlement – White Settlement Road

RFP Release Schedule: Spring 2026

Scope (preliminary):

- Investigate opportunities and constraints in the areas of transportation, economic development/market analysis, and infill opportunities to develop a Town Center/Mixed Use Development Project.
- Specific scope elements TBD. Some work may be completed in-house.

Expertise Needed: Planning, Outreach





Development of a Regional Dynamic Traffic Assignment Model for the DFW region


Likely Location: DFW region

RFP Release Schedule: Summer/Fall 2025

Scope (preliminary):

- 1. Motivation: large-scale dynamic traffic assignment (DTA) model
- 2. Model components
 - 1. Vehicular DTA model
 - 2. Schedule-based transit assignment
- 3. Process

Expertise Needed: Traffic Simulation, Dynamic Traffic Assignment, Dynamic Transit Assignment, Model Development




Automated Transportation Systems

Location: Legacy West in Plano

RFP Release Schedule: Fiscal Year 2026

Scope (preliminary): The planning, design concepts and feasibility of a Plano Legacy Area Automated Transportation System circulator

Expertise Needed: Planning, Design, Feasibility studies, Automated Transportation Systems



North Texas Zero Emissions Vehicles Project First Responder Training


Likely Location: NCTCOG Region

RFP Release Schedule: Late FY2025/Early

FY2026

Scope (preliminary): Host twelve first responder training sessions focused on zero-emission vehicles

Expertise Needed: Zero emission vehicle first responder training Anticipated DBE Goal: 9.0%



Electric Vehicle Charger Reliability and Accessibility Accelerator Program

Likely Location: Dallas and Collin Counties

RFP Release Schedule: Late FY2025/Early FY2026

Scope (preliminary): Replace existing EV charging stations with updated National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) compliant EV charging stations (23 CFR Part 680)

Expertise Needed: EV Charging Installations



Charging and Fueling Infrastructure Community Program

Likely Location: Throughout NCTCOG Region

RFP Release Schedule: Late FY2025/Early FY2026

Scope (preliminary): Install EV charging stations compliant with National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) standards (<u>23 CFR Part</u> 680)

Expertise Needed: EV Charging Installations



NCTCOG Cooperative Purchase Program TXShare

- Often an immediate need, but indefinite opportunity
- Can be used by any public-sector entity
- Intended to be recurring services from the beginning
- Deliverables are open-ended to capture everything a vendor is capable of providing for a 60 month term.
- Requires use of an ILA for entities to share the contract
- 2.5% Administration Fee for vendors to offer services
- TxShare Site
