- $\blacksquare$  FTE for H-GAC = ~2.5
- ► FTE for CAPCOG = 1
- $\blacksquare$  FTE for NCTCOG = <1.5
  - Actual numbers run by accounting team
  - NCTCOG receives the most funding of any COG
  - Does not include support staff (program assistance, accounting, communications)
  - Support staff draws on budget with little direct contribution



#### Notes

- Personnel Cost Estimates (salary, fringe, indirect)
  - Planner 2: Minimum \$85,000, Mid-Range \$90,000
  - Planner 3: Minimum \$96,000, Mid-Range \$102,000
  - Sr. Planner: Minimum: \$123,000, Mid-Range \$127,000
