### 1. **Welcome and Introductions.**

## **DISCUSSION**

2. **FY23 Project Discussion.** The group will discuss the FY23 project: Engaging reminder messages for pollution prevention/good housekeeping facility supervisors, staff, and operations staff.

NCTCOG staff facilitated a discussion on the FY23 special project, working through potential themes and outlining message details with the group. The group reached a consensus on covering the following themes with the messages: Material Storage, Inclement Weather, Special Event BMPs, Trash Management, Erosion Control, Safety Data Sheets, Mowing and Debris Management, Leak and Spill Cleanup, and Leaking Vehicles/Equipment.

Feedback received from the group included the following comments:

- Work chemical storage and secondary containment under topic of material storage.
- Skipping structural control maintenance/inspections as is too specific.
- Placing watering best management practices under topic of erosion control.
- Adding a place on the message template for a city/entity logo.
- Adding a line to “see link for more details/information” to allow for referring to additional information or resources.
- Make the message formatting friendly to being printed and posted as a flyer.

Staff will work on drafting out messages and complementary graphics ahead of the next meeting to share with the group for feedback.

3. **FY23 Training Opportunities.** NCTCOG staff will solicit members' input on training opportunities for the current fiscal year.

Staff presented the group with ideas for training opportunities in the current fiscal year and sought feedback or additional suggestions. Staff ideas were to set up a Mock Inspection and Site Tour or try the Simulated Case Study and panel presentation. Group suggestions were to look back at resources created in 2005/2006 and give them a refresh. The group also asked to receive a copy of the Simulated Case Study with meeting follow-up materials to assist in considering that option. Staff clarified that if an inspector at a city wants to present on an actual case study they've encountered, perhaps repeatedly, that fits the intent of the training.

## OTHER BUSINESS AND ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION

4. **Other Stormwater Updates.** NCTCOG staff to provide an update on additional Stormwater activities. Staff will also provide an overview of upcoming conferences, events, news, or resources of relevance to the group.

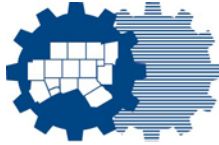
**Quiddity Engineering:** Michelle Troy is new to Quiddity and introduced herself and the that work that she does.










