

### Off-System Regional Toll Revenue (RTR) Project Closeout and Termination Procedures February 13, 2023

### **Completion of Project with RTR Advanced Funding**

Within 30 days of completion of a project, please submit to TxDOT the following information:

- 1) NCTCOG concurrence of project completion
- 2) Signed Notification of Completion document acknowledging each individual project(s) completion to the appropriate district address (see sample on following page)
  - a. Notification shall certify the date the project was opened to traffic
  - b. Notification shall include date of project completion
  - c. Notification shall include confirmation that final inspections have been conducted, if applicable
- 3) An accounting statement outlining the total RTR funds received, expended, and interest earnings on advanced funding
- 4) A check payable to the <u>Texas Department of Transportation</u> for excess RTR and interest earned. Distinction must be made from interest earnings and excess RTR funding per account (121 RTR Subaccount 1, 121 RTR Subaccount 2, etc.)

# Completion of Project with RTR Sustainable Development Funding

Within 30 days of completion of a project, please submit to TxDOT the following information:

- 1) NCTCOG concurrence of project completion
- 2) Signed Notification of Completion document acknowledging each individual project(s) completion to the appropriate district address.
  - a. Notification shall certify the date the project was opened to traffic
  - b. Notification shall include date of project completion
  - c. Notification shall include confirmation that final inspections have been conducted, if applicable
- 3) Documentation of actual project costs and total RTR reimbursements

# <u>Termination of Project with Advanced RTR Funding or Sustainable Development RTR</u> <u>Funding</u>

To terminate an agreement for a project with RTR funds approved as an advancement or reimbursement, the local government shall submit to TxDOT the following:

- 1) NCTCOG concurrence of project termination and statement about the amounts of funds (advanced RTR funds and interest earned) to be returned by the Local government
- 2) Signed Notification of Termination document acknowledging each individual project's termination to the appropriate district address.
- 3) An accounting statement outlining the total RTR funds received and interest earned on advanced funding, if applicable
- 4) A check payable to the <u>Texas Department of Transportation</u> for the refund of previously received RTR funds and interest earned. Distinction must be made from interest earnings

and the amount of RTR funds refunded per account (121 RTR Subaccount 1, 121 RTR Subaccount 2, etc.)
