89th Texas Legislative Updates

BILL	AUTHOR	STATUS	TOPIC
HB 517	Rep. Davila	Filed on 11/12/24	Watering restrictions, landscaping/vegetation, HOAs. Relating to the authority of a property owners' association to assess a fine for discolored vegetation or turf during a period of residential watering restriction. Identical Bills: HB 359, SB 542
HB 1370	Rep. Raymond	Filed on 11/18/24	Landscaping and lawn care, xeriscape. This bill relates to an exemption from ad valorem taxation of the amount of the appraised value of real property that arises from the use of xeriscape on the property.
HB 1904	Rep. Canales	Filed 1/16/25	Relating to the release of balloons and associated littering; creating a criminal offense. Bill amends the Health and Safety Code by adding a subdivision to address littering from intentional releases of balloons outside of a roofed structure. Would create Class A, B, or C misdemeanors based on the weight or volume of the deflated balloons.
