1. Welcome and Introductions.

Jim Olk, City of Garland and Vice Chair of the RCCC, welcomed all meeting attendees.

2. Summary of the October 15, 2019 Meeting.

The meeting summary was approved unanimously.

3. Regional Codes Coordinating Committee FY2020 Appointments.

Two vacancies, due to resignations, on the RCCC were discussed. Of the five nominees, the two with the most votes were Joelle Hainley, Town of Flower Mound, and Wayne Snell, City of Irving. The roster and other paperwork will be updated accordingly.

4. Electrical Advisory Board FY2020 Appointments.

Membership regulations for Advisory Boards were discussed. The RCCC approved the nominations to the Electrical Advisory Board of Roosevelt Fortson, City of Plano, Carl Spangler, City of Fort Worth, and Calvin Wayne Smith, City of Decatur, for public sector representation. For the private sector, the RCCC approved the nominations of Chris Valtierra, TX Chapter of the IAEI, Tracy Moreno, P.E., ELS Engineering, and Dan Lepinski, P.E.

The RCCC appointed officers for the Electrical Advisory Board: Chair - James Hathorn, City of Irving, and Vice Chair - Jeff McCabe, City of Dallas

5. Electronic Plan Submittal Subcommittee Activities.

Christine Hadley, City of Irving, introduced the draft Best Practices document and accompanying tables, which would be used for electronic plan submittals. The RCCC approved the documents as a template for electronic plan submittal naming conventions across the region.

Staff presented current cost share commitments. The RCCC discussed various methods of encouraging members to participate in the cast share program. Edith Marvin described the process that the Public Works Council chose, which is mailing an invoice to members across the region.
