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## **Congestion Management Process Update** 2:15 - 2:257. ☐ Action □ Possible Action Information Minutes: 10 Presenter: Mike Galizio, NCTCOG Item Summary: Work is underway on an update to the region's Congestion Management Process (CMP) documentation. Staff provided an overview of the CMP in February 2019 and will now give a brief update on CMP data-collection efforts. Staff will also present the schedule of upcoming meetings for this CMP update. In addition, efforts cataloging all construction projects to review roadway system impacts will be presented. The CMP is a regionally accepted approach for managing Background: congestion that provides up-to-date information on multimodal transportation performance and assesses alternative strategies for mitigating congestion that meets State and local needs. Federal requirements specify that urbanized areas with populations over 200,000 must implement and maintain a CMP. The current CMP for the North Central Texas region was adopted by the Regional Transportation Council in 2013. The draft UPWP document must be submitted to the Texas Department of Transportation for review by June 1, 2019, and the final document submitted by August 1.
