1. Welcome and Introductions.

Subcommittee Chair, Ranjan Muttiah, led the welcome and introductions.

DISCUSSION/PRESENTATION/ACTION

2. Approval of the April 11, 2018, Meeting Summary.

The meeting summary was approved with no changes.

3. **Service Award.** Present Lee Stimpson with Service Award for 16 years of service on iSWM Implementation Subcommittee and 2 years as Vice-Chair.

NCTCOG staff presented Lee Stimpson with a Service Award plaque and certificate. Lee introduced Allison Smith as his replacement on the committee to represent the City of Plano.

4. **Special Presentation.** Ty Thompson, City of Fort Worth Stormwater Division, will present on the evaluation of the City of Forth Worth's iSWM Development process.

Ty Thompson and Stephen Nichols, City of Fort Worth, gave a presentation with a short discussion that followed. Some takeways from this presentation included the need for development engineers to be more familiar with, and trained in, various engineering practices that are promoted through the iSWM program. The City of Fort Worth's assessment of the stormwater development review process is nearly complete, and the final report will be available soon.

5. **Regulatory Update**. The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) staff will provide an update on regulatory developments.

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NCTCOG staff gave the following updates:

- The Renewal of the Small (Phase II) Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) General Permit, TXR040000, is in progress. The most recent update that NCTCOG heard from TCEQ is that they expect the next draft to be available, followed by public comment period, in September 2018.
- The Construction General Permit (CGP) TXR150000 was renewed in March, and the grace period for active authorization to renew ended in June.
 Lee Stimpson added that all reporting will be required through electronic submission starting September 1, 2018.
- NCTCOG has been made aware of a proposed bill to amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act to provide for an integrated planning and permitted process, and for other purposes. This bill may be cited as the "Water Quality Improvement Act of 2018" and would aply to municipal wastewater and stormwater management compliance. NCTCOG informed the group that they will forward all available information to applicable interested partners.
- 6. **Regional Public Works Program Update**. NCTCOG staff will provide an update on the FY18 Regional Public Works Program.

NCTCOG staff gave the following updates:

- Construction Contracts Training with with Instructor Tim James, Halff Associates, will be held on August 14th at NCTCOG Offices.
- Public Works Roundup was held on May 23, 2018, and attended by 156 participants and 11 sponsors.
- The next Public Works Council meeting is scheduled for August 16th at 9:30 a.m., where NCTCOG will seek approval on reappointments and the FY19 Work Program
- The Standard Drawings Subcommittee is currently working towards updating the Division 1000: Erosion & Sediment Control Drawings from the Fifth Edition of the Public Works Construction Standards. The following schematics were chosen by the Standard Drawings Subcommittee, with input from iSWM and Stormwater members (via survey results), to be updated by Halff Associates:

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7. **Work Scope.** Discuss Work Scope for iSWM Task Order and projects with consultants Halff Associates, Inc.

Matt Stahl, Halff Associates, updated the group on progress made on the proprietary device resources. He brought information from other regions, to be included in the follow up email, to the group to allow them to review. The group acknowledged they would have to decide the extent to which these properity device resource findings are encouraged and/or enforced within the iSWM program.

NCTCOG staff told the group that in addition to the proprietary device resources, and the development of the 10 site development control schematics, Halff will be focusing on cohosting a BMP workshop.

OTHER BUSINESS AND ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION

8. **Construction/Post-Construction Initiative.** NCTCOG staff will brief the group on the Regional Stormater Management Coordinating Council's request for a dedicated Construction/Post-Construction Stormwater Management initiative and areas of need.

NCTCOG staff informed the group that there are plans to host a BMP Workshop in October at a location to be determined.

NCTCOG has received feedback from the TCEQ Small Business and Local Government Assistance Division on the Post Construction Stormwater Management Ordinance Template. The template is expected to be endorsed by the Regional Stormwater Management Council in September.

9. Roundtable Discussion.

NCTCOG staff: Announcing new iSWM Certified Community – the City of Irving (Certified Silver). NCTCOG staff will be presenting the award at an upcoming City Council Meeting. The iSWM website has been fully updated, as well as the NCTCOG agency website.

Mikel Wilkens – Urban EcoPlan: continuing work on the Blue-Green-Grey Project for implementing green infrastructure at bus stops in Farmers Branch. Will be presenting on this project at the upcomingTrasportation Investment Summit in Irving.

Plano: working toward adopting the new Regional Public Works Standards by September.

Mansfield: recenty installed a large unit, built by Contec. Kennedale: getting to know new City Council members.
