Storing materials in sealed, original containers indoors is always a best practice.

- ✦ Need to replace a container?
Make sure the replacement container is clearly labeled.
- ✦ If storage of materials outside is necessary, opt for a covered and paved area and inspect them regularly for corrosion or signs of leaks.
- ✦ Store materials away from high traffic areas to help prevent accidents that might cause spills.
- ✦ For indoor storage areas, use a spill containment base. Dispensing drums should have a drip pan.
- ✦ Outdoor storage areas should be bordered by a curb or containment wall to help contain spills.
